LAW

To make provision out of public revenue or other funds of Basutoland for certain services for the year ending on the thirty-first day of March, 1963. (Date of Commencement 1st. April, 1962.)

ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF BASUTOLAND.

Short Title and Commencement.

1. This Law may be cited as the Appropriation (1962/63) Law, 1962, and shall be deemed to have come in to force on the first day of April, 1962.

Public Revenue charged with R3,566,223.

2. The public revenue or other funds of Basutoland are hereby charged with the sum of (R3,566,223) Three million, five hundred and sixty-six thousand, two hundred and twenty-three rand for certain services for the year ending on the thirty-first day of March, 1963.

Purposes for which moneys to be applied.

3. The moneys granted by this Law shall be applied to the purposes and services set forth in the Schedule being the aggregates of Council expenditure for each Estimate Head as approved by the Basutoland National Council.
