## Price Control (Minimum and Maximum Bread Price) Notice, 2006

Pursuant to sections 5, 6 and 7 of the Price Control Act, 1979<sup>1</sup>, after consultation with the Board, I.

Minister of Trade and Industry, Cooperatives and Marketing make the following notice:

#### Citation and commencement

1. This Notice may be cited as the Price Control (Minimum and Maximum Bread Price) Notice, 2006.

## Bread weight and dimensions

2. The weight of a standard loaf of bread shall be six hundred (600) grammes with a loaf dimension of  $270 \times 110 \times 110$  mm.
